Site information

External doors

There is an entry code for all external doors (5674#). Please make sure they are closed behind you. You should have received a card with the code on arrival.

Front gates

The front gates are automatically locked between 5.30pm and 6.30am (10pm on Fridays). There are no Ashburnham staff on duty after 11pm. Please use the access code 5674# at all times when the gates are closed.

WiFi code

If you'd like one, please request it from reception.

Quiet please

Please refer to the information Ashburnham provides in your room and respect the times of quiet advised.

First aid

A first aid kit is available throughout the weekend at the welcome desk.

Emergencies

During reception opening hours please advise reception and they will contact the duty manager for help. Ashburnham does not have night staff, but a member of the senior team is on emergency call between 11pm – 7.30am. Please call internal extension 16573— the phone by the reception steps.

The nearest pharmacy is in Battle and the nearest A&E department is at the Conquest hospital, The Ridge, Hastings TN37 7RD, Tel: 01424 755255.

Fire alarm

In the unlikely event the fire alarm sounds, follow the exit instructions on the back of bedroom doors.

During timetabled sessions, children's helpers are responsible for bringing children in their care to the relevant meeting point for that building. If the alarm sounds during evenings, parents should collect their children already in bed and bring them to the meeting point.

Swimming & boating

Swimming and boating is **not permitted** on any of the Ashburnham Place lakes over this weekend.

Fishing

Up to 6 people may fish at any one time in specified areas of Broad Water after presenting Ashburnham staff with a valid rod license. Freshwater fish such as pike, tench, perch, roach and carp can be found on the lakes. You will also need an Ashburnham Place permit to fish which you can obtain at the main reception.

Games

There is a games room (open during reception hours) with a pool table, table-tennis tables and table football. Croquet and football can also be played; please ask at reception for equipment. You'll also be told where you can play. (Please ensure that children are supervised at all times.

Nursery

The nursery (on the ground floor at Tent Hill House) has toys and games, a kitchen with a fridge and microwave, a washing machine and an enclosed outdoor play area.

Vacating bedrooms and checking out

All rooms must be vacated by the start of the first session on Sunday morning. Please strip your beds of sheets, duvet covers and top pillow cases and leave them outside your rooms. Please return your room keys to the St Helen's welcome desk and put any lanyards in the box on the welcome table.




