**3. In the face of death, God has promised to provide a true substitute-sacrifice in whom the whole world shall be blessed (v15–19)**

'And your **offspring** shall possess the gate of **his enemies**, and in your **offspring** shall all the nations of the earth be blessed' (Genesis 22:17b-18)
