## The glorious king

Isaiah 66:1–24

### Introduction

“But this is the one to whom I will look:  
he who is **humble**...  
and **contrite** in spirit...  
and **trembles at my word.**” (66:2 ESVUK)

### 1. The proud will be brought low (v3–6)

### 2. The promise will be fulfilled (v7–14)

### 3. The praise will be for God alone (v15–24)
