Introduction: Under what circumstances might it be better not to marry?
1. Paul's general advice: now is a good time to remain as you are (7:25–28)
2. Paul's underlying reasoning: a. The things of this age are passing away (v28–31)
b. If you get married, you'll take on extra anxieties (v32–35)
3. Paul's specific application: you <i>might</i> want to defer the wedding (v36–40)
