- Four beasts and a fiery throne (v1–12)
- A son of man (v13–14)

### 2. The vision ... interpreted (v15–28)

- God has appointed beastly rulers... (v17, v19–25)
- ...but ultimately his king gets the kingdom (v18, v26–27)

Col 3:1–4, 2 Tim 2:12 (Ps 8, Heb 2:5–9)
