1. The vision of “things to come” (v1–14)

- Four beasts and a fiery throne (v1–12)
- A son of man (v13–14)

2. The vision ... interpreted (v15–28)

- God has appointed beastly rulers... (v17, v19–25)
- ...but ultimately his king gets the kingdom (v18, v26–27)

Mark 14:62 ... Acts 1:11

Col 3:1–4, 2 Tim 2:12
(Ps 8, Heb 2:5–9)

- To the world (cf 2:47, 3:29, 4:1–3, 4:34–37, 6:25–27)
- To God's people
